

Things to Remember before bringing your dog to board with us

- An evaluation is required before any dog can board with us. Current shot records and a completed Boarding Agreement/Application must be brought with you to the evaluation.
 - Food should be pre-portioned in individual baggies with each meal in its own baggie. If your dog is staying with us for 10 days or more you can bring a container of food but please bring only enough food for your dog's stay. We charge \$4/day for house food (Eagle Pack) if you choose not to bring your own.
- Make sure any supplements or medications are clearly labeled with your pet's name and the quantity and frequency they should be given.
- Make sure your dog has a quick-release collar (no choke or pinch collars) on with an ID tag with a current phone number on it. They will have this collar on during their stay so make sure it is one you don't mind if it becomes dirty.
- Make sure your dog is current on their flea & tick and heartworm preventatives.
 - You are welcome to bring toys, bedding, or anything else from home that you
 think your dog will enjoy. Tennis balls, rawhides, or other consumable chew toys
 are not allowed. Be aware that we cannot guarantee that items will be returned
 in the same condition as when brought in.

Reservations are required – pick-up and drop-off times must be scheduled in advance
